

## Support Group Speaker Consent

The Alzheimer's Association - Houston and Southeast Texas Chapter believes that people with dementia, their families, and volunteers should be the driving force behind the organization. Their well being is the Association's first priority.

Because support groups involve extensive interaction with persons dealing with the disease, and at times when they are very vulnerable, it is our desire to provide them with objective information and referral.

In order to preserve the spirit of this policy, we ask that any Speaker whose place of employment, personal experience or business provides health care, social service, respite or other services to people with dementia or their family members refrain from:

1. Using his/her involvement as a Speaker when formally or informally marketing their services to potential clients.
2. Soliciting clients at any support group meeting, through Helpline referrals or at any support or education program sponsored by the Houston and Southeast Texas Chapter.
3. Distributing marketing materials at any support group meetings or education program including brochures, magnets, pens, etc.
4. Utilizing names of participants of any support group or program sponsored by the Houston and Southeast Texas Chapter outside of that support group or program, for the purpose of marketing themselves or their place of employment.
